Shared transfers to Les Trois Vallées, France.

Le Van Rouge... a fantastic, shared transfer service between Geneva Airport and the Courchevel and Meribel valleys. Priced at 65.00 EUR per person each way, it's a door-to-door service in a brand new fleet of eight seat Volkswagen minibuses.

Building on the successes of our shared program last year, our low cost transfers will continue to be marketed under the name of **Le Van Rouge**. You may well have seen our specific, shared fleet as they're bright red in colour, as the new name suggests.

The tremendous response to our shared transfers to date means that we'll continue to run five trips to and from Geneva Airport each Saturday and four on a Sunday. Additional minibuses have been added so as to increase capacity from eight to sixteen passengers at numerous times of the day.

New for this season. A scheduled shared transfer each morning from Monday to Friday. We will continue to offer our shared transfers each afternoon during the week as well. Additional shared transfers will be offered daily when our schedule allows, as in previous seasons.

Your clients will be met in Geneva at the times specified above. There will be a maximum of eight passengers on each minibus. We will drop them off at the door to their accommodation, or as close as physically possible at least. They will receive a text message the evening before their return trip to Geneva, giving an estimated time of departure within a 10 minute window. Journey times are expected to be no more than three hours from the scheduled time of departure.
