LEVEL GUIDE

ADULT SKI

Level 1:

This is my first time.

Level 2:

I can snowplough turn competently on green runs.

Level 3:

I'm comfortable on blue runs. I'm no longer a plough turner but I'm not quite parallel.

Level 4:

I can already consistently perform basic parallel turns and feel happy on groomed red runs.

Level 5:

I'm happy tackling all pistes in a confident parallel.

Level 6:

I'm happy skiing everywhere parallel, and in varying conditions on or off-piste, steep or bumpy.

KIDS SKI

Whippersnappers (4 - 5yrs):

This is my first time.

Wallabies (6 - 12yrs):

This is my first time.

Young Arrows (5 - 7 yrs):

I can already take lifts (drag / chair) and ski green runs doing good plough turns.

Arrows (6 - 12 yrs):

Young Arrow standard but 6 - 12 yrs.

Bombers (6 - 12 yrs):

I can happily bomb down blue runs but my skis aren't always parallel.

Rockets (8 - 13yrs):

I can already ski parallel turns down red slopes.

Freeride (10- 13yrs):

I am a strong parallel skier that can ski on all pistes without any trouble.

Pro Rider (13 - 17yrs):

I'm happy skiing everywhere parallel, and in varying conditions on or off-piste, steep or bumpy.

SNOWBOARD

Level 1:

This is my first time.

Level 2:

I can turn heelside to toeside and toeside to heelside on easy terrain such as a green run, snowdome or dryslope.

Level 3:

I am happy turning on blue runs. On green runs I link my turns and carry my speed from one turn to the next.

Level 4:

I am happy riding on red runs. I can ride fast and make basic switch turns on easy slopes.

Level 5:

I can ride on all marked runs. On easy slopes I can grip and carve a narrow track in the snow. I have done a bit of off-piste and freestyle.
